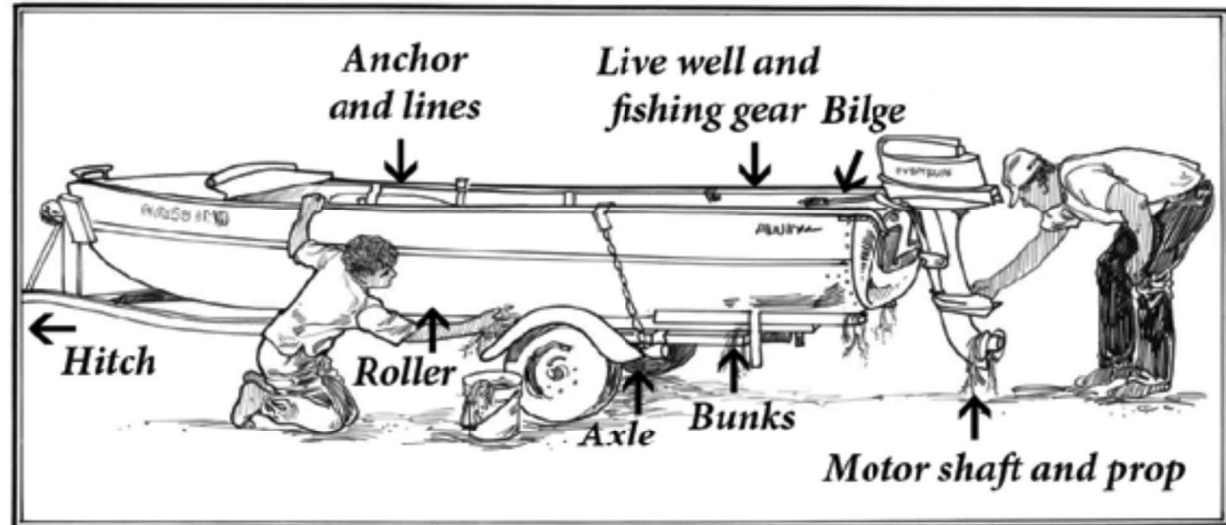

**C**LEAN off all plants (even small fragments), animals and mud from boat, trailer, and equipment.

**D**RAIN water from boat, motor, bilge, live wells and other equipment well away from water.

**D**RY boat and gear completely to kill hard to see small-bodied organisms. If you can't dry equipment, rinsing with hot, high pressure water will also remove many small-bodied organisms.

**N**EVER release plants, live fish or animals into a water body unless they came out of that body of water.
